Trinity Western decision delivers severe blow to religious freedom and diversity, say advocates

The Supreme Court of Canada's June 15th decisions on Trinity Western University's (TWU) proposed law school have delivered a severe blow to religious freedom and diversity, say advocates. The court delivered two rulings affirming the decisions of both the Law Society of Upper Canada (Ontario) and the Law Society of British Columbia not to accredit the future law school. At issue was the private university's mandatory community covenant, which requires students to abstain from sexual activity outside of traditional marriage between a man and a woman. <u>Read more</u>

And from the bishops ...

Archbishop J. Michael Miller of Vancouver, in whose diocese Trinity Western is located and who intervened in the court case, condemned the rulings in no uncertain terms. "The decision runs

counter to Canada's tradition of balancing rights and freedoms, and the implications of this decision for constitutional freedoms in Canada are severe. I agree with the ruling's dissenting justices, who pointed out that the decision "betrays the promise of our Constitution that rights limitations must be demonstrably justified" and that the law societies' powers are not absolute with respect to approving law programs. Full statement

Bishop Mark Haegmoen of Saskatoon, who once studied at TWU himself, issued a pastoral letter calling the ruling a "great concern for all who support faith-based education in our country... Please continue to advocate for public policies that respect and uphold the clear and broad protections of conscience and religious freedom that are a bedrock of Canadian law." Full statement

The Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops, also an intervenor in the case, said the decision "effectively means that provincial law societies can discriminate against lawyers on the basis of their religious affiliation and moral values. Furthermore, any organization is now at risk for its views on equality, diversity and inclusion if it depends on a regulatory body with a mandate to act in the 'public interest.' This means that the Court's interpretation of 'public interest' ... has serious implications for all private faith-based educational institutions, and could have negative repercussions for religious charities and other organizations." Full statement


